Topic I— People (Domestic Church—Family)

Explore: Our family trees. Reveal: The family of God in scripture.

Topic 2— Called (Baptism/ Confirmation—Belonging) Admitting wrong, being reconciled with God and one another. Explore: the response of being chosen. Reveal: confirmation: a call to witness. Explore: the gift of love and friendship.

Reveal: Advent and Christmas: the church's seasons of preparing to receive God's gift of love and friendship in Jesus. Core Vocabulary


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

In Autumn 1, they will develop their understanding of the features of a recount as they write up their experience of our school trip.


In Autumn 2, the children will focus on newspaper reports, culminating in their own coverage of the events of an Ancient Greek myth.


Wider Reading

Unit I: Reasoning with 4-digit numbers


Solve number and practical problems with increasingly large numbers; identify, represent and estimate using different representations.






Unit 4: Discrete and continuous data

Solve, compare, calculate, interpret and present data using appropriate graphical methods; understand line graphs.



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
