- The Baptismal candle

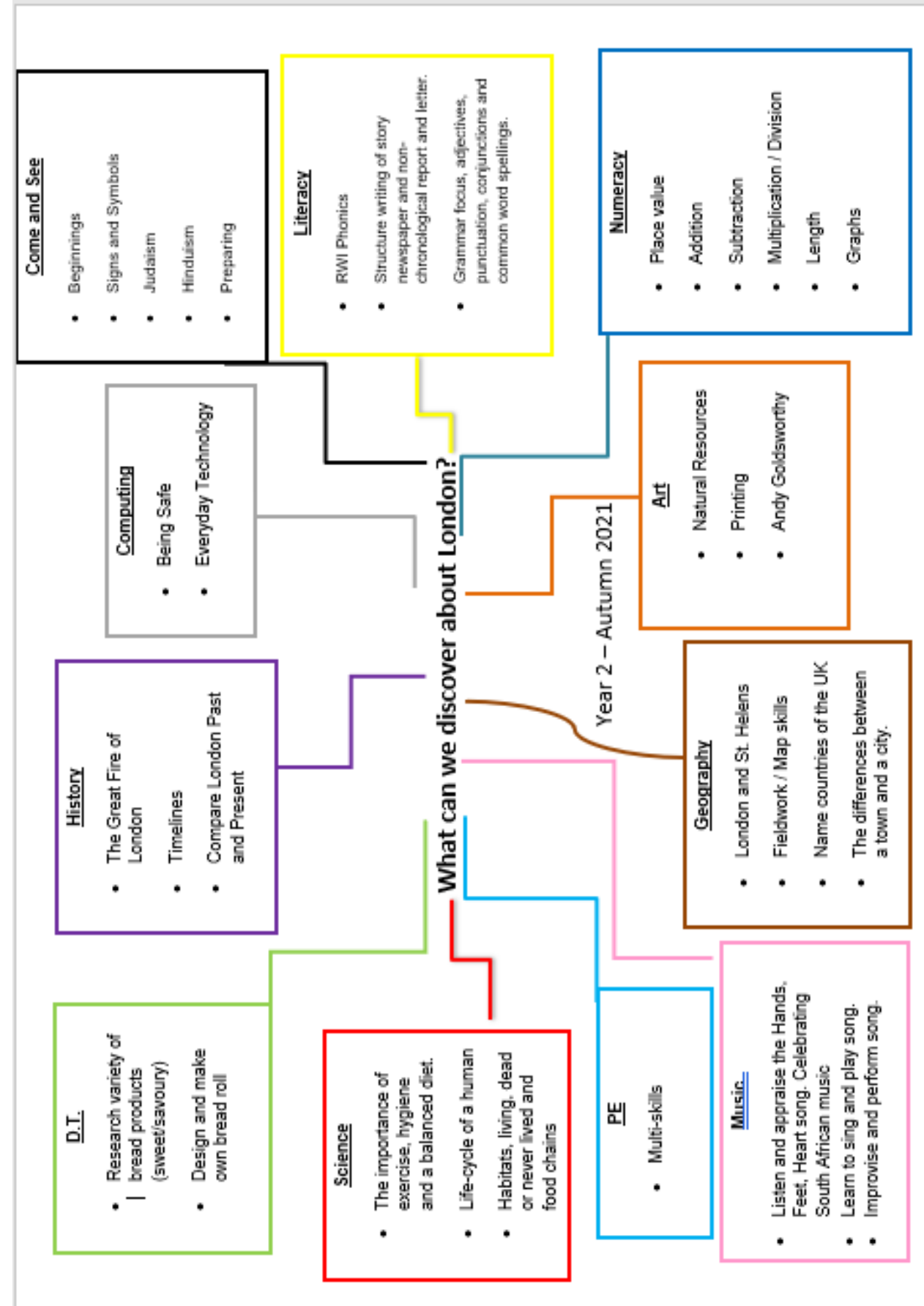

What can we discover about London?



Numeracy

This term we will be focusing on the four operations of number

(+, -, x, ÷)

Some of the areas include:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 2digit number
- Know 10 more/less than any number up to 100
- Read, write and order numbers up to 100
- Know number bonds to 20 instantly
- Add and subtract mentally up to 2digit numbers
- Recognise odd and even numbers up to 100
- Know by heart 2, 5, 10 times tables and recognise the corresponding division facts

Literacy

This term we will be exploring different genres including Fiction and Non-Fiction.

Reading

- Decoding words automatically and fluently
- Make predictions on the basis of what has been read
- Draw simple inferences from events and characters' actions
- Retrieve information from a text

Writing

- Simple sentences
- Stories with familiar settings
- Grammar—conjunctions, noun phrases and punctuation
