

# Year 2's Autumn Curriculum



### **Numeracy**

This term we will be focusing on the four operations of number  $(+, -, \times, \div)$ 

Some of the areas include:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 2digit number
- Know 10 more/less than any number up to 100
- Read, write and order numbers up to 100
- Know number bonds to 20 instantly
- Add and subtract mentally up to 2 digit numbers
- Recognise odd and even numbers up to 100
- Know by heart 2, 5, 10 times tables and recognise the corresponding division facts

### **Literacy**

This term we will be exploring different genres including Fiction and Non-Fiction.
